MBI CHAIR REPORT – MAY

Step 5: Admitted to God, to ourselves, and to another human being the exact nature of our wrongs.

In doing Step 5, we choose another human being we trust to share what we have written in our 4th Step writing. It all starts with our relationship with our Higher Power. That Power helped us in our writing and now is present with us and another person as we share that writing. Often this person is our sponsor but it is up to us to choose a person we trust. Much is written about this process in our 12 Steps and 12 Traditions of OA and in the Big Book.

When I did my last 5th Step, I shared every bit of my writing, even though there were experiences there that I was ashamed of and was afraid to share with another person. "Yet, we find that we haven't truly admitted our wrongs to ourselves until we speak about them with someone else. It is only through the process of discussing our shortcomings out loud with an understanding person that we can finally begin to know ourselves and accept ourselves. Nothing in us can be changed until we first accept it." *The 12 Steps and 12 Traditions of OA, p. 48.*

Higher Power was with us as I read my writing, represented by a candle and a chair. My sponsor was understanding and never reacted judgmentally. Sharing that writing was the beginning of a gradual acceptance for me. My shame has gradually eased and I believe that is related to my own gradual surrender of my self-judging to the forgiving Love of my Higher Power.

What does MBI provide for our member groups?

We have a small office in Arlington where Marina, our part time office assistant works, and where materials, files, our phone and computer are housed. Marina responds to calls and emails, sends out our meeting directories, professional packets, and our newsletters (to those unable to get them in other ways). Marina is generally in the office on Mondays and Thursdays but not at regular times. Call for appointments.

We have a website that has links to our newsletter, meeting lists, and events calendar as well as flyers for workshops and our retreat and links to Region 6 and the OA website. Anyone can sign up on the website to have our newsletter emailed to them. Under the heading *What is OA?* at the top of our home page (click on those words) are some recordings of members sharing their recovery stories, the pamphlet "Is Food a Problem for You?" and a downloadable resource for professionals.

This is only a partial list. Thank you, Jean B and Jeanne K, for helping me with this part of my report. It will be continued next month.
