MBI Chair Report- December 2016

Greetings!

This is my final report as chair of our MBI Intergroup. It has been a privilege and honor to serve you in this position for the last two years. I am grateful to a Higher Power who has directed and guided our intergroup during this time. We have strived to be guided by the *Tradition 12* instruction "...to place principles before personalities". Your support is what has allowed our intergroup to be able to reach out to those who are still suffering from the disease of food addiction.

Some of the new projects you have championed: being a Designated Downloader for your meeting - bringing news and information to your meeting from the intergroup, our region(6) and World Service; the Coming Back to OA - A New Beginning" workshops reaching out to those in relapse or coming back; participating in outreach for health fairs throughout Massachusetts bringing OA to health professionals and people still suffering from this disease; doing service for two conventions in the Boston area - Region 6 and World Service; offering a Fall Retreat at the Espousal Center; financially supporting three (one last year and two this year) members to represent us at the World Service Business Conference in New Mexico.

In addition, you have continued to support our ongoing Professional Outreach, Public Information and 12th Step committees. Finally, four of our fellowship attended an intergroup workshop sponsored by Region 6 learning how to strengthen our intergroup and be more effective in carrying the message.

Thank you especially for your ongoing financial support. It allows us to have a viable intergroup and provide the services needed to support you in your recovery and to reach out to those still suffering.

On behalf of your Massachusetts Bay Intergroup (MBI) representatives, I wish you a healthy and abstinent Holiday Season.

Our income was good for October with 825.00 in retreat entries, 1706.72 in group donations (see list at the end of this report), and 30.00 for the MBI 7th tradition collection.

Expenses were interesting in October. The big expense was the retreat. We had

previously paid \$1000 for a deposit and the balance was 2795, which was paid before the event. The cost was 165 per person, we had 23 people including several who paid at the retreat itself, so it came out even 3795 total out, 3795 income paid in over a number of months. We were fortunate that we did not have to make up the difference from the 30 people that we contracted for. We paid a refund of 165.00 to one person who was injured and unable to attend, and a 35.00 refund to someone else who paid the \$200 fee before we announced that we were keeping the price at 165. I purchased some supplies for the retreat including name badges, decorations, tablecloths for the tables in the meeting room, office supplies, etc. for a total of 130.54; some of these items can be used next year. I would suggest that if we have a retreat next year that we charge a few dollars more per person than the base cost to cover extra expenses. I have talked to the retreat center and it is not clear if we will be able to go back next year as they may be booked up.

Non-retreat expenses included 230.00 for Pat at the office, 41.37 for office supplies, 405 for office rent, 25.00 to the hospital for the MBI meeting, 50.00 webmaster, 250.00 each quarterly donations to Region 6 and WSO, 151.50 for phone and internet, 15.00 reporting fee to the Commonwealth of Massachusetts as a non-profit, and a 25.00 check to Region 6 for the IGOR officers training workshop. We received back the 2 checks I had written for the workshop to be voided as they only wanted them as a guarantee that we would show up, so I added back 50.00 in October (the other check had been written in September).

Our upcoming expenses will include our annual liability insurance which gets paid in December, we will be evaluating an offer which may be a less expensive option than the company we have now. Our website is being worked on, when the transition is complete it will be easier to use, it will cost us a few hundred to do but will save money in the long run. We can afford this.

As this holiday season approaches, please consider making an extra donation to MBI in honor of someone in program or in gratitude for your own recovery. MBI donation envelopes will be available at the Thank-athon.
