MBI CHAIR REPORT - April Hello everyone.

It seems like such a long time since March and the March 2020 edition of the MBI Newsletter. So much has changed in our lives and the world. We have lost physical contact with the people, places and spaces where we found, and shared, experience, strength and hope. We are powerless over all of the changes and losses, yet we are hope-full. The Tools, Steps and Traditions of our OA program help us access, as needed, an infinite power, far greater than ourselves, to restore us to sanity.

I have been writing about the Tools of the OA program this year and so, this month, I am writing about meetings. This is such a higher power moment in some ways. Of all the 9 Tools, the pandemic has impacted my committed meetings the most obviously. My plan of eating, the vast majority of my contact with my sponsor and sponsees, the OA literature, the AA Big Book, writing, my individual action plan, and use of the telephone are thankfully, still highly accessible. However, my committed meeting places, where I have gone 3-4 times a week for the past number of weeks, are closed to our usual "gatherings of 2 or more compulsive overeaters." We cannot simply relocate physically this time because, as we know, the gathering itself is an issue.

I know that there are established and wonderful phone/virtual meetings but like many members, I wanted to stay connected with people who have seen and heard me, and whom I have seen and heard, through the years. "Well, that's exactly what" members made happen.

It has been such a gift and a pleasure to get the Call or Zoom information for MBI affiliated, in person meetings that chose to meet virtually for now. Some groups' conscience decided that they wanted the temporarily virtual meeting information posted on the MBI website and available to whoever saw it. Other groups chose to use word of mouth amongst the regularly attending members and their sponsees, to keep the meeting "local" and familiar.

It is wonderful to hear long-timers who shared that they have never been to a phone meeting in all of their years in program but when given the chance to stay connected to their committed meetings and "peeps", they "show up." These members are ongoing powers of example and examples of their Higher Powers at work in them. I am so grateful they are willing to call, Zoom, adapt and continue to share their experience, strength and hope.

I have also heard from members whose recovery started at local MBI, in person meetings, but continued in the different cities, states and countries they moved to. It has been beautiful to have them back, for a time, and for them to be able to attend their old, home meeting, while it is temporarily virtual and accessible.

In one committed meeting, the speaker who lives far away, in a remote area, shared about never having been to a face to face meeting. The speaker went on to say how being in the Zoom "meeting room", and getting to see whoever was sharing or reading, was like having attended a face to face meeting-from 2,000 miles away.

We convened the March MBI business meeting on the phone and in April we will meet in a Zoom virtual "conference room". An MBI member is personally hosting the meeting but MBI has purchased a Zoom account so that

any MBI in person meeting can meet virtually, without any cost, during the pandemic.

The MBI sponsored monthly Step 4 workshop will meet virtually, as did last month's on Step 3. The workshop is Saturday, 10:30am-Noon, on the phone or via Zoom.

Region 6 "Reps" were notified that the OA Region 6 Spring assembly was cancelled. It was scheduled for Saturday, 4/18/2020, in Albany, New York and is the first of the 2, semi-annual, Region wide business meetings convened every year. Region 6 encompasses parts of Southern Canada, all of New England, New York, and Bermuda. The essential, time sensitive business will be conducted via phone, Zoom and email. We will miss the in person fellowship with the Reps from across the Region. I know I am amazed and grateful that we can still do what needs to be done.

For a number of reasons, we only recently heard that the annual OA World Service Business Conference "WSBC", was cancelled. The Board of Trustees has an Action Plan so we can meet virtually and get the requisite business done. One of the 3 Delegates MBI is eligible to send to the "WSBC" is newly elected. She will not have the experience of in person fellowship with OA members from all over the world, this year. However, she is still doing service, reviewing the resumes of the OA member candidates for Trustee and considering four(4) motions about some OA literature changes. All of the 181 Delegates have a way to ask questions, get information, and cast their votes. It is very different, a bit sad, and ultimately, amazing that we can still gather at all as the planetary group conscience of OA.

I sincerely thank each and every one of you, whether you host or chair, attend an MBI temporarily virtual, or an established, permanently virtual meeting, your showing up makes the meetings happen. A couple of sayings come to mind, "Meeting makers make it" and "Zero meetings in 7 days, makes one weak." Thank you for helping to keep our local MBI meetings going and for making virtual meetings easy to access. I hope and pray for our collective, maximum wellness and for the quickest, most comprehensive end to suffering.

The list of groups who donated in February is at the end of this report. **Thanks to all of you who are supporting MBI.**

Our February expenses: We reimbursed Jeanne K. \$1343.86 for her flights (\$529.69) and hotel room (\$814.17 for two delegates) for the upcoming World Service Business Conference. We paid \$777 for MBI's office insurance for this year. We spent \$459.20 for additional literature from OAWS. We paid \$455 for February office rent. Marina was paid \$262.50 for her work from 1/27/20 to 2/7/20; extra time was needed this month to go through and to order literature for the Addiction Conference, make new newcomer packets and update the MBI meeting list. Our Verizon bill was \$167.95. We paid Staples \$149.99 for a new computer for our office (bought during the year end sale 12/99). We paid Lawrence Memorial Hospital \$75 (\$25 for our 2/8 MBI meeting, \$25 for the Coming Back to OA Workshop 2/15, and \$25 for the Step 2 workshop on 2/22/20). We paid the Post Office \$59.03 for stamps and postage. Jeanne Kendall was paid \$50 for her January website work. Saintly Solutions was paid \$8.70 for their monthly web site hosting.
