My Program | Faith Journey

I was grateful to be asked to write on my Program (Faith) Journey for the MBI Newsletter. This dovetails so nicely with a commitment I am taking this evening: "Am I willing to accept spiritual help?" If I don't get a chance to share tonight, I am content in being able to share with you, now.

Is "My Program Journey" the same as "My Faith Journey"? For me, it is. Even all these years later I can still feel a bit self-conscious that perhaps this sounds fanatical or that I will turn people off by saying that the entire purpose of my demise via eating (bankrupt on every level) was to put me in touch with God and that my program is entirely about deepening that relationship. But for me that is true. When I am eating compulsively or when food takes on a higher importance in my life, I reap nothing but pain. And when I put God first and my program first, life goes so infinitely much easier.

I heard a quote today, "No one is born wise", and how true that is. The hope is that we learn from our experiences. When I first came in, they said to always share your numbers because this gave people hope and even fortifies my own faith. My last top weight was 213 pounds. It took me about a year to lose 90 pounds at a rate of about 8 pounds a month which, at the time, didn't seem fast enough. However, buying my way through four brandnew pants sizes was pretty darn good. It took many long hard years of pain and humiliation to get to my current "wisdom" and willingness. So now I pray every day that I retain and grow in this state.

In summation, I guess I'd just like to say that abstinence and life and contentment and my proximity to God gets easier and easier and better and better. Where I used to have to ask God for help with patience getting to meals, I no longer do. My meals are great, but they don't outshine the love for my nephews or joy in my friends. "What is the question? God is the answer". I don't have to take inconsiderate people's heads off anymore, and I don't beat myself up for sometimes reacting or feeling fear. Instead, I pause. I know this will pass. And then I say "thank you". Thank you for letting me talk about faith and trust and wisdom.

PI/PO/Diversity Committee March:

This was what Jeanne reported at our PI/PO Working Group Meeting April 1. We discussed this at length. Jeanne committed to creating 1 ad in AdWords, and Will committed to writing something for the website about men in OA.

Report from R6 Meetings:

- Jeanne K attended the Region 6 meeting on March 28 to present our PIBlitz application for outreach funding. Diane was also there in support. Our request was accepted on the condition that I amend the application because there was no money committed from MBI. Jeanne changed the cost of AdWords to be a total of \$900.00, \$300 of which would come from MBI and \$600.00 from Region 6. Jeanne amended the application the same night and sent it to Lynda B.
- 2. It seems that every Blitz funding application from other intergroups involved AdWords or website work.
- 3. On Tuesday evening Jeanne also attended the R6 Web & pub meeting. Most of the discussion was about what Region has done for AdWords, as well as Metro-West Intergroup. The discussion involved the price of keywords in ads, as well as how to coordinate between different intergroups that may be in competition for AdWords.

- 4. Jeanne asked the Metro-West webmaster if she thought they got a lot of traffic from their Facebook page, and she said no.
- 5. The most successful strategy is an ad targeting the 15 questions, which we had thought of. However, the Metro-West webmaster has a link to an interactive questionnaire (very slick). Jeanne thought perhaps we could link ours to a survey, another good idea from the workshop of words to use. (At the Working Group meeting April 1, we discussed building this into the MBI site rather than making it a separate survey link to make sure traffic goes to the MBI site.)
- It was reported at the R6 Web meeting that most of the respondents to online ads were in younger age groups -the most hits were from women ages 18-24, and 2nd most hits were from women 25-34.
- . Metro-West has a chat function that will connect you with an OA person very useful.
