The Position:

- Starting in 2015 as a trainee, I have served since 2016 as the chairperson of the 12 Step Within Committee of OAMBI. I worked professionally on zoom beginning in 2018, so when Covid came and we all moved to zoom and telephone, I volunteered to host all OAMBI activities. I chaired this committee with assistance from others.
- The goal of the 12 step Committee is to facilitate passing the message of Abstinence to OA groups within and outside a 100 mile radius of the MBI Office. I have accomplished this not by travel but by way of zoom meetings, where we have been in touch with people from all over the United States, Canada, Europe, Israel, and more.

- This is a position you grow into. I started when my sponsor said, go to MBI meetings, and then a program fellow at MBI meetings told me to volunteer for this service position, and then she taught me how to do it and I did it as I fulfilled the 1 year abstinence and 1 year MBI service requirements. 
WSBC OA Annual Events

The World Service Business Conference established the following annual events. World Service Business Conference 2023 Wrap-Up Report 13

- 1) OA Birthday: The third full weekend (Friday included) of January as the annual celebration of the January 19, 1960 founding of Overeaters Anonymous.
- 2) Unity Day: The last Saturday in February in even years and the last Sunday in February in odd years at 11:30 a.m. local time.
- 3) Sponsorship Day: The third full weekend (Friday included) in August.
- 4) International Day Experiencing Abstinence (IDEA): The third full weekend (Friday included) in November.
- 5) Twelfth Step Within Day: December 12 (12/12) each year be designated as OA's International Twelfth Step Within Day, the purpose of which will be to encourage OA service bodies, meetings, and individual members to reach out to those within the Fellowship who are still suffering from compulsive eating behaviors
