I like it when the chapter states "Most good ideas are simple" AABB page 63. I can do simple.

I took the 3rd Step kneeling and holding hands with my sponsor on 12-22-03. When we finished with the 3rd Step Prayer Eleanor said I was under a sacred contract and that meant I was to go on with the rest of the steps. I was willing to move forward and liked very much the 3rd Step Promises on the top of page 63 in the AABB that offered me the kind of life I wanted but could not achieve on my own. This must mean I'm under the care of a Higher Power's care and didn't even realize it. That's just how the AA book says AA started, they didn't even realize at the time. How Profound.
